

## FRIDAY £1K PAYDAY COMPETITION SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These competition terms and conditions should be read together with, and are in addition to, Nation Broadcasting’s standard terms and conditions which can be found at <https://nationradio.wales/wp-content/uploads/2016/01/Competition-Terms.pdf> (the “**General Terms**”). Together these specific competition terms and conditions and the General Terms shall be referred to as the “**terms**”.

<p><b>ITEM 1: COMPETITION</b></p>	<p><b>FRIDAY £1K PAYDAY</b> (the “<b>Competition</b>”).</p>
<p><b>ITEM 2: PROMOTER</b></p>	<p>Nation Broadcasting (t/a Swansea Bay Radio), registered office: St. Hilary Transmitter, Nr. St. Hilary, Cowbridge. CF71 7DP (the “<b>Promoter</b>”).</p> <p>This is a Nation Broadcasting Network competition, running across the following radio stations:</p> <p>Nation Radio Wales, Nation Radio Ceredigion, Nation Radio Scotland, Sun FM Radio, Dragon Radio, Bridge FM Radio, Swansea Bay Radio, Radio Carmarthenshire, Radio Pembrokeshire, Your Radio,</p>
<p><b>ITEM 3: WEBSITE</b></p>	<p><a href="http://Win.nationbroadcasting.com/1k-payday">Win.nationbroadcasting.com/1k-payday</a> (the “<b>Website</b>”).</p>
<p><b>ITEM 4: COMPETITION LAUNCH AND CLOSING.</b></p>	<p>Entrants can enter the Competition via text (see below) or via the <b>Website</b> from 06.00am on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> September (the “<b>Launch Time</b>”) until 16:00 on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020 (the “<b>Closing Time</b>”).</p> <p>Any entries received before the <b>Launch Time</b> or after the <b>Closing Time</b> (for whatever reason) will be invalid.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 5: ENTRANT RESTRICTIONS</b></p>	<p>The <b>Competition</b> is open to UK and Channel Islands residents aged 16 years or over on the date of their entry.</p> <p>Employees (and their family members) of the <b>Promoter</b> (or any company in the same group) or any company involved in the <b>Competition</b>, are excluded from entering the <b>Competition</b> and their entries will not be considered.</p> <p><u>Entrants must obtain permission from the bill payer before texting to enter the <b>Competition</b>.</u></p>

<p><b>ITEM 6: ROUTES OF ENTRY AND COSTS</b></p>	<p>The <b>Promoter</b> will broadcast the <b>Competition</b> between 06.00 on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> September and 16.00 on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020. There are two ways of entering the <b>Competition</b>.</p> <p>The first route is by texting the keyword PAYDAY to 84915. Entries received before the Launch Time or after the Closing Time will not be counted but may still be charged. Texts will cost £1.50 from the UK plus the entrant's standard network message charge. Entrants will receive a bounce back message to confirm entry. If an entrant texts a second time from the same mobile number (at a further cost of £1.50 plus their standard network message charge) they will automatically be entered into the draw a 3rd time free of charge. Participants may enter the Competition more than once, but will be restricted by a maximum cost to the entrant of £12 plus their standard network message charges. Once this maximum has been reached the entrant will not be able to enter the Competition again.</p> <p>If the message does not start with the valid Keyword, or is not sent to the valid number, it will not be entered. Entrants will receive an automated SMS response to their SMS message confirming their entry.</p> <p>The second route is via the station <b>Website</b>. Entries received before the <b>Launch Time</b> or after the <b>Closing Time</b> will not be counted. On-line entry is free. Participants may enter the <b>Competition</b> more than once on-line but will be restricted by a maximum of 18 entries. Once this maximum has been reached the entrant will not be able to enter the Competition from the same email address again.</p> <p><u>The Promoter is part of the Nation Broadcasting group of radio stations. The competition will be promoted across some of the group's radio stations - these are Nation Radio Wales, Nation Radio Ceredigion, Nation Radio Scotland, Sun FM, Dragon Radio, Swansea Bay Radio, Bridge FM Radio, Radio Pembrokeshire and Radio Carmarthenshire. There is only one prize across this group of radio stations for this competition.</u></p>
<p><b>ITEM 7: DRAW DETAILS</b></p>	<p>The winner will be chosen by electronic random draw from all entrants who successfully texted in the keyword PAYDAY or entered on-line within the stated contesting time.</p> <p>An entrant will only become a winner if they are confirmed during a conversation with the promoter's representative as the winner.</p>

<p><b>ITEM 8: WINNER ANNOUNCEMENT</b></p>	<p>Entrants who are randomly selected will be contacted by the phone number provided with their entry. This may be live on air or off-air to be played out at a later time.</p> <p>The winner will be announced on each of the radio group's drive-time show on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September. However the promoter is not responsible for the late announcement of a winner due to any mobile network or any technical issues associated with the promoter or any third parties.</p> <p>The winner must aim to be contactable between 16.00 and 18.00 following the competition closure at 16.00 on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2020. The Promoter will record and broadcast a call to the winner.</p> <p>The name, hometown, photo and any video or audio recording of the winner may also be posted on the Promoter's Website and / or social media platforms.</p> <p>By entering the Competition, the entrant is automatically consenting to being called and having their name and location announced on-air.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 9: PRIZE DETAILS</b></p>	<p>A single prize consisting of £1,000 will be awarded to the winner subject to the winner complying with all the terms and conditions applicable to the Competition:</p> <p>The prize will be awarded after the winner has provided a valid photo ID and proof of address.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 10: DATA PROTECTION</b></p>	<p>Entrants' personal data (which can include telephone numbers and addresses) will be collected by the Promoter. Entrants personal data will (regardless of whether they opt-out) always be used to process their entry.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 11: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONSENTS</b></p>	<p>Entrants consent to their voice being used on the Promoter's radio broadcasts and to a copy of this broadcast (the "<b>Recording</b>") being stored by the Promoter for exploitation in any and all media for promotional or other purposes.</p> <p>To the extent possible, entrants agree to assign to the Promoter the title to any intellectual property rights or interest that they may have in the Recording.</p>

<p><b>ITEM 12: OTHER CONDITIONS</b></p>	<p>Only entries received in accordance with these Terms will be accepted.</p> <p>The Promoter has the right to disqualify participants if it reasonably believes participants have breached any of the Terms.</p> <p>If there is any misunderstanding, mistake or dispute concerning the operation of the Competition, including the operation of any technical or communications system, the Promoter’s decision shall be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into on this subject.</p> <p>The Promoter has no responsibility or liability if participants fail to get through when they text to enter.</p> <p>The Promoter is not responsible for any costs associated with entering the Competition, including texting or accessing the Website.</p> <p>Whilst participants are on-air, they promise not to make any statement which (in the Promoter’s sole and reasonable discretion) is inappropriate or which would be likely to bring the Promoter into disrepute.</p> <p>Other than for death or personal injury resulting from its negligence and so far as is permitted by law, the Promoter hereby excludes all liability for any loss, damage, cost and expense, whether direct or indirect, howsoever caused in connection with the Competition or any aspect of the Prizes.</p> <p>The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, amend, terminate or temporarily suspend this Competition if it is required to do so due to circumstances outside its reasonable control, with no liability to any entrants or third parties.</p>
